Critical Incident Procedures

As a school we are required to have procedures in place for a security lockdown within the school and what to do if we need to evacuate the school for both fire and other serious reasons such as a flood, electrical issue or threat of a terrorist attack. Although it is unlikely that our school will ever need to implement these procedures it is important to have arrangements in place to deal with such situations. This is an important part of our Critical Incident Plan and keeping your child and the staff safe at school.

During Focus Group time next week, we will be explaining to students what we will do as a school if there is ever a situation where we need to lock down for a period of time. The purpose of a lockdown such as this is to prevent an intruder from causing harm to students and staff. During the process, entrances to the school would be secured and staff and students would find a suitable place to remain out of sight.

Our intention is to explain to students what we would do in these situations and how as a school we would use different alarms for different scenarios. We are required to carry out annual practices, in line with local authority guidance.
