We would like to invite you to our **Choices Evening on Wednesday, 24th April 2023 16:00 - 18:00**. This evening aims to give you the opportunity to see the broad range of subject areas and qualifications that are available to your child, in advance of them choosing their options subjects this year. During the evening, you will be able to see the different areas of the school, learn about some of our subjects, and meet our staff and the student leadership team. Please arrive at the school reception at any time during the evening where we will greet you and provide information.

Below, you will find information about the curriculum your child will be studying over the next three years at Kelvin Hall. We have designed our curriculum to offer students a broad and balanced range of subjects, to provide students with an outstanding set of academic qualifications, and to suit the strengths and needs of individual students.

When students move into Year 9, they have the opportunity to choose preferences for **three** of their qualifications: Choices 1, 2, and 3. Wherever possible, we aim to provide students with their first preferences for these subjects, but this is not always possible.

All students study for qualifications in: English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Combined Science or Separate Sciences, Statistics, either Geography or History; either Languages or Travel & Tourism. Most students will then study two other qualifications. The curriculum your child will follow is shown below.

Students will start the learning for these chosen qualifications in September 2024. There is a range of qualifications to choose from, including GCSEs and vocational qualifications. Each of these subjects will be assessed slightly differently, and you may want to consider what type of assessments and study students will be best suited to.
