# School Notices

#### Confiscation of mobile phones

We still believe that students benefit from a complete break from the pressures that mobile devices can bring when they are in school, including the pressures of social media and the distractions they bring. **We recommend that students do not bring their mobile devices to school**. When referring to mobile devices, this includes: mobile phones, audio/music devices, video devices, etc.

We appreciate that some students have a long journey to and from school and that parents and carers may feel more reassured if they can contact their child during this journey. For this reason, students are permitted to bring a mobile device into school, as long as it is switched off (not just on silent mode) and in their bag out of sight from the time they enter the school grounds until they leave the school grounds at the end of the day. <a href="Parents/carers should not contact their children via mobile phone as this breaches our mobile phone use rule in school. If parents need to contact their child, they can do so via reception or the pastoral team.</a>

Students who do not comply with these expectations will have their devices confiscated until the end of the day. The device will be securely locked away. If this reoccurs, then parents/carers will be required to come and collect the mobile phone from school, and further breaches will result in the student no longer being allowed to bring their phone into school. If students do not comply, this will result in escalating sanctions.
