School Car Park - Reminders of Rules & General Etiquette



Please be reminded that our school car park is for <u>visitors and staff use ONLY</u>. Parents/carers should only use this car park when visiting the school for a meeting or urgent enquiry and not for general pick-up and drop-off.

Parents/carers with a car park pass or a blue badge may use the car park and park in the appropriate spaces. Parents/carers without a pass will not be admitted at the start and end of the school day. The school car parks are not big enough to allow access for parents/carers. Please be aware that you may endanger the safety of students and pedestrians if trying to reverse out of the car park entrance.

Furthermore, if you do not have a blue badge, please DO NOT park in the dedicated disabled spaces. These are reserved for blue-badge holders only. There have been a few reports of parents/carers parking on those dedicated spaces without a blue badge, and preventing use by staff and parents/carers with a genuine need.

peer pressure




parental influence

DNP, an active ingredient in some pills, was **reclassified as "poison"** by the Government.

Doug Shipsey, whose daughter died in 2017 after consuming the chemical, had campaigned to highlight DNP's role in deaths.



10% of girls used "very dangerous" diet pills in the past year (survey conducted by researchers from Deakin & Monash universities, on 604,552 children)



5% of under-18 boys and girls took **weight-loss aids without a prescription**, for intentional weight loss.
