#### End of Year Exam Year 7 - Year 10

EOY Exams for all year groups will commence on Thursday 22nd June. A timetable of these exams will be communicated with you, and they can also be found on our <u>Curriculum website</u>.

These exams, which will take place in classrooms or in the Performance Hall are an excellent opportunity for pupils to demonstrate to their teachers the learning they have been doing for the academic year.

The EOY Exams are also the occasion for young year groups to experience the feel of an exam hall ahead of Year 11 and perform under exam conditions.

#### **Reminder of Uniform and Expectations**

You can find information on our uniform on our school <u>website</u>. If you are struggling to provide uniform items, please contact your child's year leader and we will be happy to support you with this. A reminder of some expectations is shared below.

**Jewellery** - One ring, one pair of small stud earrings, and one discreet bracelet are allowed. No necklaces are allowed in school. No facial piercings of any kind are allowed under any circumstances.

Hairstyles, Makeup and Nails - We allow natural makeup and accept a wide range of hairstyles. All we ask is that a student's hair is smart, and of a single natural colour. Nails must be of a short, safe length. The school does not allow false nails or any other decorative embellishments.
