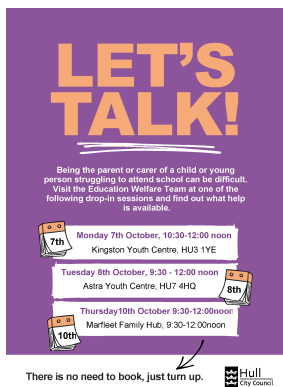
The After-School Clubs' timetable is live on [our website](#). Please ensure you regularly check it for any potential new additions. As a reminder, all after-school clubs are free to attend.
