Dear parents and carers,

We are delighted that your child has been offered a place at Kelvin Hall School, starting in September 2025. We are looking forward to welcoming you into the Kelvin Hall School community.

During the coming weeks and months, Miss Lowthorpe, who will be your child's Pastoral Year Leader in Year 7, and Mrs Jarvis-Johnson, Transition Coordinator, will be contacting primary school staff and arranging online Google Meets or visits to speak to the children who are joining us. Miss Lowthorpe will also share additional information about Kelvin Hall School in preparation for September 2025.

Whilst moving from primary to secondary school is an exciting time for children, it comes with lots of change and some challenges. Please be reassured, that there is lots planned to make sure your child has a good start at Kelvin Hall.

As a school, we focus on maintaining an ethos of Hard Work, Respect and Independence in everything that we do. This means that students will experience these elements in every lesson and event that they take part in. Their first taste of this will be the upcoming Induction Evening and Transition Week in July this year.

Induction Evening (Wednesday, 2nd July 2025)

All parents and Year 6 children will be invited to attend Kelvin Hall School on the evening of Wednesday, 2nd July. We will contact you closer to the date with the final arrangements including the times of the evening. During the evening, information will be given about Kelvin Hall, and you and your child will get to meet key staff members at the school. As well as receiving important information regarding Transition Week, your child will also be able to try on and order school uniform, ready for September 2025.

Transition Week (Monday, 7th to Friday, 11th July 2025)

All Year 6 children joining us will attend Kelvin Hall for a full week, starting Monday, 7th July. Pupils should be at school on Monday, 7th July for 9:00 am, and 8:40 am on Tuesday to Friday. The school day will end each day at 2:40 pm to allow students to exit before the rest of the school is dismissed. Our Transition Week has always been effective in boosting the confidence of our new starters as they become familiar with the building, new staff, subjects, and the increased number of students. Again, you will receive further details closer to the time.

We will send our Admission Consent Form via email on a Google Form. This will be sent to you in the week commencing Monday, 17th March 2025, to the email address that we have for you, which is the same one you are receiving this attached letter to.
