School Car Park - Reminders of Rules & General Etiquette



Please be reminded that our school car park is for **visitors and staff use ONLY**. Parents/carers should only use this car park when visiting the school for a meeting or urgent enquiry and not for general pick-up and drop-off.

Parents/carers with a car park pass or a blue badge may use the car park and park in the appropriate spaces. Parents/carers without a pass will not be admitted at the start and end of the school day. The school car parks are not big enough to allow access for parents/carers. Please be aware that you may endanger the safety of students and pedestrians if trying to reverse out of the car park entrance.

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Staying Safeguarding Savvy



