I would also like to remind you that we have lots of available uniforms on our 'new to you' rail and we are always happy to support parents and carers who may be struggling to provide uniforms for their children, please just get in touch.

Y11 - MFL Speaking Tests

GCSE Speaking tests are fast approaching for our Year 11 French and Spanish students. They **start on Wednesday 17th April.** Here are some top tips for them to help with their revision:

- For the chosen presentation topic:
 - o chunk your learning and focus on learning one sentence at a time
 - o If your teacher has made an audio recording for you, listen to this to perfect your pronunciation
 - Practice saying it aloud to anyone who will listen, or even to yourself!
 - o If there's a tricky bit that refuses to stick, take it out! As long as the sentence still makes sense this is fine.
- For the Key Questions:
 - o Read over the answers you have prepared and try to remember key verbs and structures to use in each one
 - o extend your answers and add further detail with and. but, also, because
 - o Make sure your knowledge of tenses is strong. Use your revision flashcards for this.

Remember that **little and often works best** when learning a foreign language. If your child has not started revising for this exam yet, please encourage them to start as there is too much for them to learn if they try to cram it all into the night before.
