The School will continue to operate as normal throughout the day and continue to deliver our curriculum.

All other events that would normally be on our previous Mock Results Day will still take place this term but will be completed during Core PE, Focus Group, and PSHE lessons. These sessions aim to give students strategies for success with college, employment interviews, individual careers guidance, practice employer interviews, CV writing, and revision sessions. Students have already taken part in study skills workshops and they have additional workshops scheduled this year.

At 15:30 – 18:30 on the same day, we will be holding our Year 11 Parents' Evening. This evening is an opportunity for you and your child to have a 5-minute appointment with each of your child's subject teachers. We hold this additional evening so you can be given the most up to date information regarding GCSE outcomes in the summer term and to discuss your child's recent mock results. **Due to the ongoing COVID-19 restrictions and for everyone's safety, this event will be held virtually.**

During the evening, you will be given further information on the mock exams taken in December as well as their current working grade; we will also give you details of revision and examination resources to enable you to further support your child. Attendance to this evening is vital as this is such a crucial time in your child's education.
