Students are required to apply for a place on the Speakers for Schools' website <https://www.s4snextgen.org/students/Take-Part>.

Once registered, select "Opportunities", then filter by date and click on "view opportunity". Remember to check the closing date for applications and make sure you meet the eligibility criteria.
