# Safeguarding Savvy

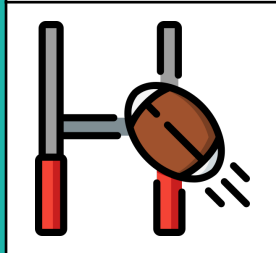
