**Congratulations to all Year 7, 8 and 9 students who completed the online Maths and Computational Thinking Competition** ran by Oxford University (Bebras), in their Computer Science lessons recently!

The competition was age-related so the following year groups have done extremely well to finish in the top 10% of the country. 14 Year 7 students finished in the top 10% nationally, 4 Year 8 students finished in the top 10% nationally, 5 Year 9 students finished in the top 10% nationally, and 1 Year 10 student also finished in the top 10% nationally!
