Equipment for School

Students must have their lanyard and card, planner, a blue or black pen for writing, a red and green pen for marking and feedback, a pencil, ruler, rubber, pencil case and a suitable bag for school. A pack of equipment can be purchased for only £2.60 through our ParentPay store.

All students have an allocated locker and are required to pay a £3.00 refundable deposit for the key. Deposits can be paid through our ParentPay store. We recommend all students bring a bottle to school in order to use our water fountains.

Transport to School

Due to limited parking and the safeguarding of our students, private cars belonging to parents and carers are not allowed on-site or down the entrance road to Wyke. If you need to drop off or collect students, please park carefully on Bricknell Avenue, and with respect for our neighbours.

Sadly, despite our best efforts, a number of bike thefts have taken place from our site. Please ensure your child has a high-quality lock and they use this to secure their bike in the locked bike shed. Furthermore, please encourage the use of a cycle helmet as all routes around the Kelvin site can be very heavy with traffic.

Please note, that electric scooters are not permitted on the school grounds and students must not bring these to school.

Reminder of Uniform and Expectations

Jewellery - One ring, one pair of small stud earrings, and one discreet bracelet are allowed. No necklaces are allowed in school. No facial piercings of any kind are allowed under any circumstances.

Hairstyles, **Makeup and Nails** - We allow natural makeup and accept a wide range of hairstyles. All we ask is that a student's hair is smart, and of a single natural colour. The school does not allow false eyelashes. Nails must be of a short, safe length. The school does not allow false nails or any other decorative embellishments.

Energy drinks and chewing gum are not allowed in school. The rule on chewing gum is now even more important, as this can be dangerous to Lizzie, our school wellbeing dog.

Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete
