## Promoting Children's Mental Health at Kelvin Hall School

Mental health and wellbeing for all is a high priority at Kelvin Hall School. We believe that, despite primarily being a place of education, it is our responsibility to develop the whole child. We know that if a child comes to school distressed then it is impossible for them to achieve their full potential academically and that we need to address any issues to help them to access learning.



Next week is Children's Mental Health Week and we will be taking the opportunity to address mental health issues in assemblies, focus groups and PSHE lessons.

With this week in mind, we wanted to share with you all of the things we do at Kelvin to support your child's mental health.

- We have a designated Wellbeing Zone in school where students can come if they are feeling overwhelmed or need to talk to someone about their mental health
- We have two full-time members of staff who are dedicated to supporting students with their mental health and wellbeing (these are Mrs Counter - Designated Wellbeing Lead and Miss McDaid - Wellbeing Coordinator)
- Our students are excited to begin spending time with our latest "staff member in training" - Lizzie, our trainee Wellbeing Dog!
- Wider mental health support is also available for students internally from our Pastoral, Safeguarding, SEN and First Aid teams
- All staff are given regular training in how to promote and support positive mental health in school
- In addition, we also work closely with a number of external agencies including our School Nurse, Advotalk, Life Skills Hub, Turn 2 Us and Mind
- Mental health and wellbeing matters are addressed in school through assemblies, Focus Groups and PSHE lessons
- Our website contains advice and guidance for parents and students on a variety of mental health issues

## Gab & Grab! Kelvin Hall's Community Pantry

Kelvin Hall has partnered with FareShare to prevent food waste and support communities. Every Friday at 14:00 parents and carers can join us to grab a bag full of shopping for a bargain price of £1 and chat with staff including our SEND and Attendance teams.
