As part of their start to school, Year 7 students will be completing a number of online tests over a two-week period starting the week commencing 3rd October. These tests are provided by GL assessment and will give teachers essential information about students. We will also report the outcomes of these tests to you in a report. Students will complete:

- Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4)
- Reading and Spelling Tests
- Progress Tests in English, Maths and Science
- PASS Wellbeing Test

Students do not need to prepare for these tests, but they are expected to give each test their best effort and embody our school values of hard work, respect, and independence.
