Dear Parents and Carers of Year 7, 8 and 9.

You will be aware that the government has recently asked primary schools in England to prepare for wider opening to some primary year groups. Secondary schools have been asked to offer some face-to-face support to supplement the remote education of year 10 students **only** at this stage. As you may know, we have been working intensively recently to support some of our students with improved access to online learning. We will actively continue with this work over the coming weeks.

During the partial school closure, we have of course continued to provide places for children from key worker families and vulnerable children across all the schools in our Trust. Staff have worked extremely hard with this and we have been glad to play our part in supporting the national effort and the NHS.

Following the request for primary schools to open to some year groups, the government gave detailed guidance on the measures they believed primary schools should be taking to prepare for this. However, following recent government announcements it now seems clear, as far as we can tell, that pupils in Years 7-9 are unlikely to be returning to school before the summer holiday, although we will continue to monitor the DFE/ Government advice.

We will be continuing with the present system we have in place for home learning over the summer term. Students should try to complete the work set to the best of their ability. It is important that students maintain a balanced approach to learning, however, we realise that every circumstance will be different.
