Re: School Trip to Wimbledon – Thursday, 9th July to Friday, 10th July 2026

We are excited to inform you about an incredible opportunity for our students in Years 9 and 10 to experience a memorable two-day trip to The Championships at Wimbledon, in July 2026. This trip promises not only a unique sporting experience but also educational and cultural enrichment.

Trip Details:

- **Dates:** Departure on Thursday, 9th July 2026, and return on Friday, 10th July 2026
- **Destination:** Wimbledon and London

What's Included:

- **Coach Travel:** Two days of coach travel, including pick-up and drop-off at our school.
- **Accommodation:** One-night stay at a good standard hotel.
- **Meals:** Continental breakfast included.
- **Event Tickets:** Seated tickets at No.1 Court for The Championships at Wimbledon, with access to Courts 3 through 18.

Costs:

The total cost for the two-day trip, including all the above, is **£350 per student**. We believe this price provides excellent value given the breadth of experiences available on this trip. The payment plan is scheduled as follow:

Pupils' names will be selected in a random drawing process (lottery) on Friday, 24th October using the responses to this form (duplicate answers will be deleted), and parents/carers will be contacted on that same day (Fri. 24/10) to confirm that a place has been allocated to their child. Parents/carers with more than 1 child should complete this form once for each child.
