

# Year 10 Reopening Information and Expectations

As part of national social distancing measures to limit the spread of coronavirus, we need to limit the numbers of students attending school and adhere to strict guidelines, to ensure that students and staff coming back into school can do so safely. The following information and expectations will apply to all Year 10 students. Please make sure you and your child have read this together, and fully understand the new procedures before sending your child back into school.

## School day

- Every Year 10 student has been allocated to a team and group - this is shown clearly in the Parent/Carer letter.
- Your child must only attend school on their allocated day and time. The bakeshed will be opened 10 mins before the start of each session.
- Students will not be able to enter the school without a member of the senior leadership or pastoral team. All doors into the school will be locked.
- Students will need to line up at the front of the school building, at their allocated start time, and in the correct area for each team (shown on the map on the reverse page). Students should only arrive on the school site 10 mins before their group start time. If they are late by more than 10 mins, they will be asked to go home.
- Students will line up and wait to be registered before entering the school, they will need to remain 2 metres apart during this time. Upon entering the school, they will be asked to wash their hands or use the hand gel provided. We will do this one student at a time.
- Each group throughout the week will have its own classroom. This will remain the same for all 4 sessions in the day, and every week they are in school.
- Students will have their own numbered desk, chair, equipment, and Chromebook. They will not need to move from their desk to collect any additional equipment.
- Students will be given a 15-minute break for a snack (provided by the school), toilet break, and a bit of fresh air. These break times will be staggered so only 1 group at a time will be outside.
- During the 15-minute break, the senior leadership and the pastoral team will supervise students and remind students of social distancing if necessary.
- After the last session has finished, students will be escorted out of the building. Please make arrangements for your child to be picked up at their finish time to avoid students congregating around the school site.

## Expectations

### Social Distancing

All students will need to follow the government's social distancing guidance and stay 2 metres apart from other students and staff.

### Movement

Student movement around the school will be limited (barriers and signs will clearly indicate this) and students will need to adhere to this.

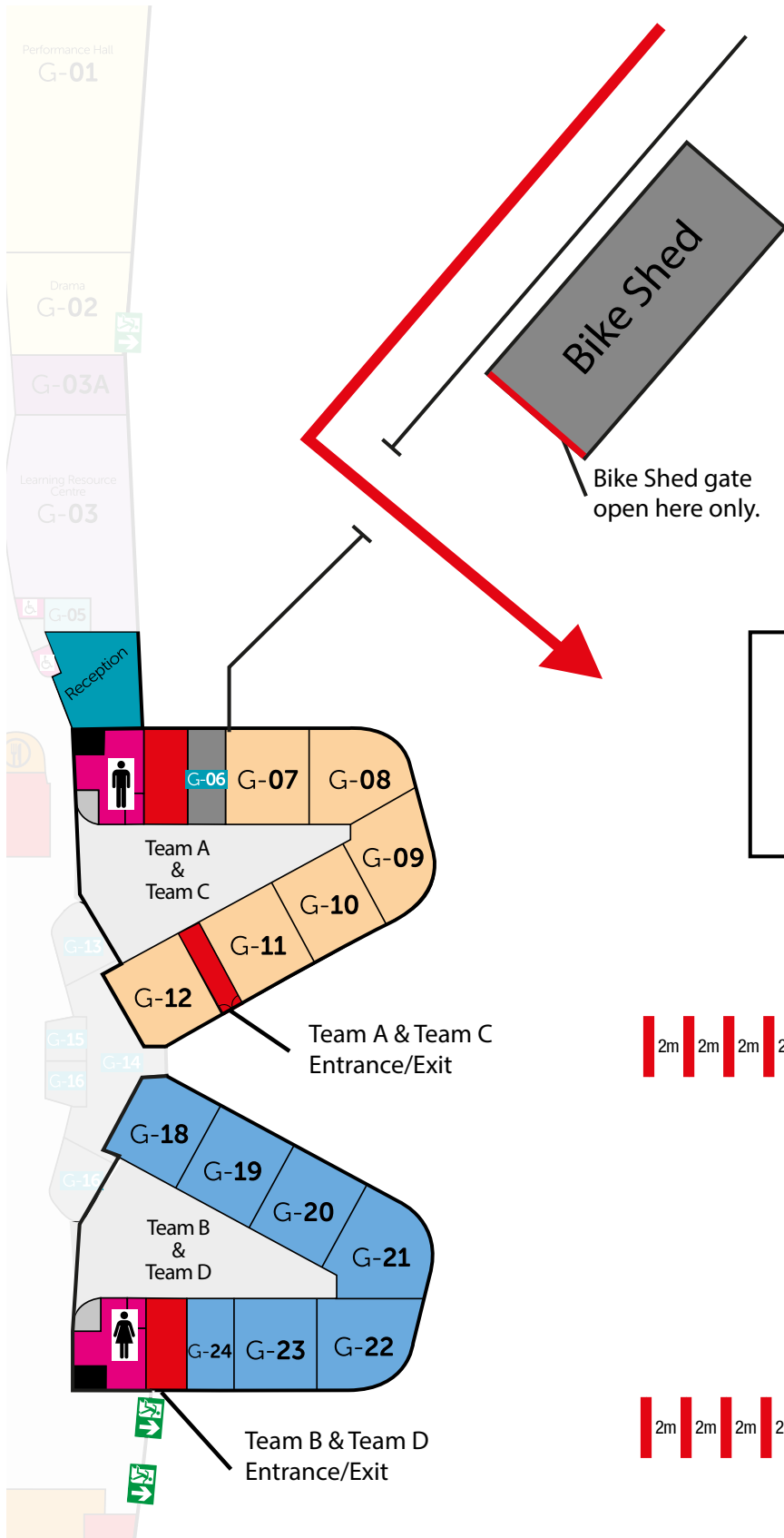
### Uniform
