How we share praise and communicate problems with behaviour

Arbor has arrived! You will have noticed this week that we are communicating with you differently this year. This includes changes to some of our processes for praising students and communicating any problems with their behaviour in school.

If there is a 'yellow' or 'amber' problem with a student's behaviour in school and we need to put a sanction in place, you will receive an email and a text message with details of the problem and the sanction. If a more serious 'red' incident occurs, you will receive a phone call explaining what has happened and what we need to do about this.

Pupils will continue to be awarded positive points for their efforts, their achievements, and for demonstrating our school values. When students receive this praise from staff members you will receive an email or text message to let you know. 'Bronze' praise will arrive by email, 'Silver' and 'Gold' praise will arrive by text message. When pupils go above and beyond during lessons, they may also be rewarded with an 'Extra Mile' postcard from a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

This year, we have replaced our rewards store with a broader variety of rewards and exciting events. Some most popular rewards will remain and be available as rewards for excellence, improvement and consistency in attendance. For example, queue jump passes and Amazon vouchers will feature, along with half-termly Focus Group prizes for attendance.

Pupils no longer need to spend positive points. Students who earn lots of points in school will be recognised and rewarded with 'Kelvin Experience' events which will take place every half-term. Each half-term, students with high positive points will be given a golden ticket to attend one of three planned experiences.

Next week, we will share Arbor Parent Portal logins with you. This will replace the Class Charts account used previously and will also allow you to access more information. Over the next few weeks, we will add more information for you to this portal.
