Dear Parent/Carer,

Once again, we are all very much looking forward to the Christmas holiday after a long and very challenging autumn term for everyone. I would like to pass on my thanks to everyone involved in the Kelvin Hall community for all the support, hard work and dedication this term. As ever, school life has been busy and diverse; but our students have adapted and coped well with the new routines and changes to learning both in school and at home.

Over the last term, a number of our year groups have spent time learning from home, continuing their learning using the resources and live lessons provided through Google Classroom. We would like to say special thanks for your support this term and for the valuable feedback you provided about our home learning arrangements. We have been continually impressed with the students' commitment to and enthusiasm for learning from home. Please note, additional learning resources will not be provided over the Christmas period and we strongly encourage students to take a break from their learning.

#### Recent Government Update

On Tuesday the 8th December 2020, all Schools were asked by the Department for Education to consider closing to students at the end of Thursday 17th December and turning Friday 18th December into a non-teaching training day. The recommendation for FE colleges is that they also close to students on Thursday 17th December. The rationale for this is that Public Health England have agreed a six-day window, after the final day of teaching, in which schools are required to remain contactable to assist with contact tracing. School leaders will then be on call until the end of Wednesday 23 December.

This concession still leaves school and college leaders potentially having to undertake contact tracing for a significant proportion of the first week of the holiday. It also leaves us responsible, at very short notice, for informing families that they **may** need to self-isolate over the Christmas period if we receive a positive confirmation and 'contacts' are traced (this, I believe, is not the position schools and families should have been placed in over the Christmas period).

Therefore, the school will now close on **Thursday 17th December 2020** with all students leaving at their normal finish time. It may be likely that some other secondary schools in the city and the East Riding may be closing on this date.

To finish this term in a positive way and to support our local community, we would like to have a non-uniform (Christmas Jumper) day on Thursday 17th December 2020. All money raised will go towards supporting the elderly in our local community and Hull Foodbank - a local charity that aims to end hunger and poverty in Hull. Kelvin Hall's fundraising always reflects our students' commitment and their generosity in helping others. All donations will be collected at the start of the day as students line up outside the front of school.
